YMCA FLATWATER ROUNDBALL TOURNAMENT Saturday and Sunday – March 5 & 6, 2022

- **ENTRY FEE:** Fee is \$130.00 per team for both boys and girls divisions. YMCA team fee is \$90. Please make checks payable to the Grand Island YMCA. Late fee is \$20 per team. Each team must pay with one check payable to: GRAND ISLAND YMCA. A \$75.00 fee will be retained if the tournament is cancelled because of weather. The Grand Island YMCA reserves the right to refuse any team. Refusal is dependent, in part, on behavior of team, coach and fans in previous tournaments.
- LATE FEE: Any registrations received after Friday, February 5, will need to pay a \$20 Late Fee.
- GAME SITES: Check schedule for your game site. Various sites may be used.
- **BRACKETS:** Teams will be placed in brackets up to eight teams. Each team will be guaranteed a minimum of three games. Although this is the rare occurrence, the YMCA reserves the right to combine grades to fill a bracket. In the unlikely event a team doesn't play a scheduled game, the opposing team is granted a forfeit win, which counts as one of the three games guaranteed.
- **PLAYERS:** Players must compete in their own grade classification. Exception: younger players may participate in older divisions. Players can only play on one team per grade and cannot play down. Violations of this may render a player and/or team ineligible.
- **NOTIFICATION:** You will be notified via email (provided your email address is included with your team registration form) when we receive your registration. Team packets will be at your teams first game. We will also post brackets and results at game sites.
- AWARDS: Individual medals will be awarded to the top three teams in each division (top 2 teams in divisions of four teams)

ADMISSIONS: Adult Pass: Saturday \$6 Sunday \$6

Student Pass: Saturday \$3 Sunday \$3

Coaches: Wrist bands must be picked up at the site of the first game. Two coach passes per team. Required for both days. Coaches will be charged admission if not wearing the wrist band. We no longer require player passes.

SCOREKEEPERS Two paid officials and one clock operator will be provided for all games. The team designated as HOME on **AND OFFICIALS:** the official score sheet must provide a scorekeeper for each game.

- **RULES:**
- Games will consist of four 8 minute quarters
 - •Clock stops only during a free throw situation or when a time out is reported by a referee, except during the last minute of each quarter when regular high school rules will apply. Intermediate 28.5" size ball will be used for all divisions.
 - •The official chooses which team's ball will be used as the game ball.
 - Time-outs will be one minute, each team receiving two time-outs each half with no carryover.
 - •A team cannot full court press once they have a lead of 10 points or more.
 - Half court and full court press will be allowed in both Boys and Girls divisions.
 - •Clock will not start when the ball is in the backcourt during the last 30 seconds of these games if the score is within 5 points or less.
 - Overtime will last 2 minutes in which regular high school rules will apply. Sudden death will occur after the first overtime, starting with a jump ball.
 - •Tournament site directors will settle all disputes. If a player or coach is ejected from a game, they must have permission from the tournament directors to participate in any future games.
